Milton Mobility Hub Study - A Hub of Possibility

The study is looking at how the area around the existing Milton GO station could be re-imagined as a **Mobility Hub**. A Mobility Hub is the transit station and its surrounding area with increased levels of planned transit services. It has the potential to be a focus for a mix of uses in a pedestrian friendly and transit oriented neighbourhood.

Purpose

This study will be used to define and enhance Town policy related to the transit-oriented development and design considerations needed to create a vibrant mobility hub.



Study Process

This study will consider the following elements to facilitate growth in this area:

- Land use
- Urban design
- Transportation improvements
- Utility improvements

The study area for this project is shown on the accompanying map.

The transportation component of the Study will identify suitable multi-modal facilities to help facilitate intensification within the study area. These could include wider sidewalks, dedicated cycling facilities and transit vehicle priority measures, among other options. The analysis will also consider vehicular operations within the study area. The transportation component is being completed as a master plan, which is consistent with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Process for Master Plans. The Town will work with stakeholders and members of the public to identify and review potential transportation alternatives. Ultimately, the selection of the preferred alternatives will form part of the Town's transportation network.

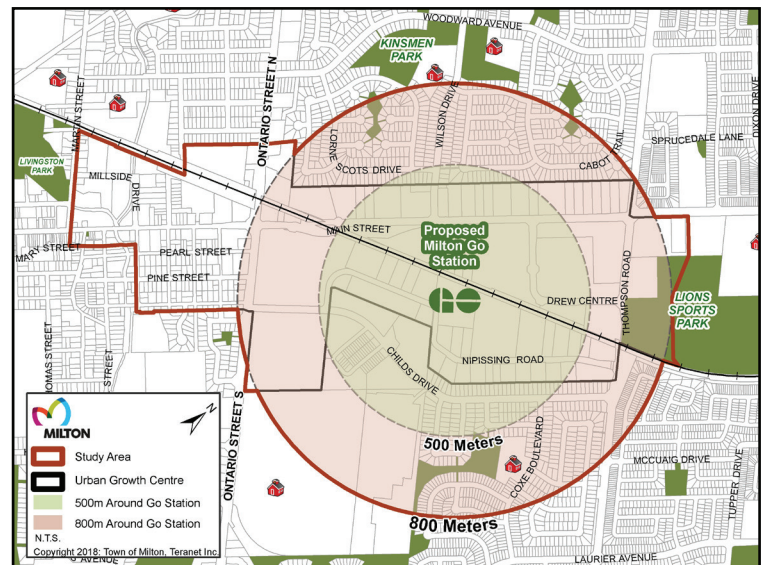
