The study area for **the SWS** goes beyond the identified urban growth area and includes subcatchments of the main, east and west branches of Sixteen Mile Creek. The entire SWS study area encompasses approximately 5260 hectares (13000 acres).

### What is the Subwatershed Study?

**The Subwatershed Study (SWS)** is intended to assess environmental features and functions within the study area and to provide recommendations for the protection and management these features as part of future planned development.

The purpose of **the SWS** is to:

- Inventory, characterize and assess natural hazard, natural heritage and water resource features and functions within the study area (i.e., constraints to development);
