



# Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Commencement and Public Information Centre #1

## Agerton Employment Area Secondary Plan and Trafalgar Corridor Secondary Plan

The Town of Milton has initiated Secondary Plan programs and a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process for the lands identified as the **Agerton Employment Area Secondary Plan** and the **Trafalgar Corridor Secondary Plan** (see accompanying map).

Prior to commencing this work program, the Town initiated two background studies, the Land Base Analysis and Subwatershed Study to gain a better understanding of the opportunities and constraints related to developing these areas.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of these Secondary Plan programs and Class EA process is to build upon the background studies completed to date, establish a detailed planning framework, and development concept for infrastructure and land use for the Agerton Employment Secondary Plan and Trafalgar Corridor Secondary Plan.



#### **Study Process**

The study process will address the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment requirements with respect to the planning and layout of any arterial or major collector roads in the Secondary Plan areas by fulfilling Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the Class EA process.


