## Thinking of Renovating?



### Renovations or construction on your property

If you have plans for decks, fencing, sheds, swimming pools, hot tubs or other improvements, please contact the Building Division to ensure what you have planned is allowed, and to determine if you require a building permit.



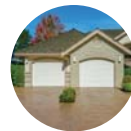
### Accessory apartments

All accessory apartments (sometimes referred to as secondary suites or basement apartments) new and existing, require a building permit and must comply with any applicable laws and standards including the Building Code, the Fire Code and the Town of Milton Zoning By-law.



### Individual lot drainage/grading

If you have purchased a new construction home, your lot will be graded by your builder to comply with Town of Milton standards. A permit is required if you want to change the grade in any way.



### Driveway widening

Milton's Zoning By-law requires every house to have a minimum of two parking spots. If you purchased a newer house with a single-car garage, you have one parking spot in your driveway and one in your garage. The Zoning By-law regulates driveway widths and surfaces on your property. Please contact a Zoning Officer before making any changes to your driveway or adding hard landscaping to your property.

## Parking in Milton

The Town of Milton Parking By-law limits on-street parking to a maximum of five hours, unless otherwise posted. Parking is not permitted between 2 am and 6 am. Milton provides street parking exceptions (weather permitting), which allow you to exceed the five-hour limit or park between 2 am and 6 am.

A limit of 18 considerations per plate/per year applies.
