Generally, qualified applicant(s) must be:

- A resident of the Town of Milton, or:
- An owner or tenant of land in the municipality, or the spouse of such an owner or tenant;
- A minimum of 18 years of age on the date of appointment;
- Employee(s) of a business located in the municipality or student(s) attending a school located in the Town of Milton.

The Committee is established under the Planning Act with a mandate to consider applications for:

- minor variances from the Zoning By-law;
- changes to legal non-conforming buildings,
- structures and land uses;
- land division (consent to sever land).

The Committee is also responsible for hearing appeals of Orders issued under the Town's Property Standards By-law.

Applicants should have knowledge in one or more areas of: law, planning, architecture, government, economic development, community development, land development, environmental planning or citizen advocacy.
