**PROPERTY OWNER'S PERMISSION TO DISCHARGE EXHIBITION
FIREWORKS RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION**

As the Commissioner of Community Services for the Town of Milton and as per Article 14 'Prohibition' of Fireworks Bylaw 37-2009 I am aware that The Town of Milton has made an application to discharge Exhibition fireworks on Town property located at 805 Santa Maria Blvd. Milton Community Park and by signing this form, I grant my permission for this activity to occur. I acknowledge that the discharge of fireworks is a high-risk activity and that it poses a danger of damage, injury or death if not conducted safely. I acknowledge further that the discharge of Exhibition fireworks may have one or more conditions attached to it and understand that violations of these conditions may result in the revocation of the permit by the fire department.

In consideration of the granting of a permit to discharge Exhibition fireworks by the Chief Fire Official, I hereby release and forever discharge and agree to indemnify and save harmless the Town of Milton Fire Department, servants and agents from any and all action, cause of action, claims and demands for damages, loss or injury to persons or property sustained by any person or persons in consequence of discharging Consumer fireworks, said discharge of Consumer fireworks being the subject of the permit application.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERTAND THE ABOVE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT DISCHARGE OF EXHIBITION FIREWORKS IS A HIGH RISK ACTIVITY. IN WITNESS WHEREOF I HAVE HERE UNTO SET MY HAND AND SEAL AT MILTON ONTARIO.
