What can you expect when you come back to the Seniors' Activity Centre

- All participants and staff will be required to wear a non-medical mask unless due to health conditions they are not able to. For fitness programs, you will not be required to wear a mask once the class has commenced.
- Reduced program sizes to ensure at a minimum, a 2-metre distance between participants.
- Participants are encouraged to wait either in a vehicle or physically distanced outside before their activity. Wearing a face covering is highly recommended for those waiting in line to enter the facility.
- Individuals must follow the orange lines along the pathway when entering the Centre.
- We've staggered program times to allow for an uncongested entrance to the facility and Reception Desk. You may have to wait outside for a few minutes, so please dress accordingly.
- \bullet You will only be able to enter 5 10 minutes prior to the start of the program and are asked to leave immediately following the program.
- Inside the Centre floor markings, such as signage and indicators will be used to visualize boundaries and to encourage physical distancing.
- Participants are asked to arrive prepared and in appropriate attire to begin their activity and limit exposure to others in common areas, such as restrooms.
- Hand sanitizer is located at Centre program room entrances and exits. Participants are encouraged to use these stations.
- Once your program ends, you will be asked to leave through the exit doors within the room your program is held in (unless otherwise noted.)
- No sharing of program equipment. Please bring your own mat for fitness programs if required.
- Debit or credit is the preferred method of payment for in person transactions at this time.
- Coffee/tea and meal service will not be offered until further notice. The cafeteria will remain closed.
- The lounge is closed. We are not accepting any book or puzzle donations or are able to loan these items out.

- All hallway furniture has been removed. There is no seating and/or waiting areas available at this time.
- Restroom capacity Main level 2 individuals at one time, Lower level 1 individual at one time.
- Enhanced cleaning protocols will be followed. Program equipment and rooms will be cleaned and sanitized after each use
- All staff will have been trained on updated standard operating procedures that relate to COVID-19, the new work environment and protection of staff and participants.
- At this time, the town will not be renting out any rooms at the Centre, to help minimize the spread of COVID-19.
